## Things to look for

- 1. Internal inconsistencies
- 2. Inconsistencies with other, especially objective evidence
- 3. Poor opportunity to observe light, duration, distance, angle
- 4. Contamination and information from different sources
- 5. Reference to or reliance on things post-dating incident
- 6. Capacity to recall given personal characteristics, time since incident, whether contemporaneous records available
- 7. Assumptions
- 8. Reconstruction
